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The Hon'ble Minister, Labour & Employment, Government of India, Shram Shakti Bhawan, New Delhi.

Sub: Modifications to be made in Para 22A of the EPF Scheme – reg.

Sir,

Please refer to the above subject. The EPF Officers Association would like to place the following on the above subject for your kind consideration.

In the EPFO, by virtue of the powers vested under Sec. 5D(3) of the Employees' Provident Fund & Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 "the Central Board may appoint [subject to the maximum scale of pay, as may be specified in the Scheme, as many Additional Central Provident Fund Commissioners, Deputy Provident Fund Commissioners, Regional Provident Fund Commissioners, Assistant Provident Fund Commissioners and] such other officers and employees as it may consider necessary for the efficient administration of the Scheme [the [Pension] Scheme and the Insurance Scheme]." and as per the Scheme provisions under para 22A, "the power to appoint vested in Central Board under sub-section (3) of section

5-D of the Act shall be exercised by the Board in relation to posts carrying a maximum scale of pay of Rs.[14,300 to 18,300].]" now Rs.37400 – 67000, Grade Pay 8700 under 6th Pay Commission.

As per the above provision of the Act, the Central Board was the appointing authority of all posts upto the post of Additional Central Provident Fund Commissioner from the post of Assistant Provident Fund Commissioner when the . Central Provident Fund Commissioner was in the pay scale of Rs.37400 – 67000 with Grade Pay Rs.10000 [(pre-revised Rs.18400-22400) i.e. Joint Secretary Post which is one level above the appointment power of the CBT].

The Government of India vide letter No. A-12018/2/2008-SS-I dated 26.05.2009 upgraded the post of CPFC to the level of Secretary with the pay scale of Rs.80,000/- (fixed)(Pre-revised Rs.26000/- fixed) with effect from 1st January, 2009. Consequently, a modification for inserting maximum scale of pay which will be lower than one grade of CPFC under para 22 A of the EPF Scheme has not been made.

Though as per the Act, the Central Board has the power to appoint Addl. Central Provident Fund Commissioner, but recently two posts in the scale of Grade Pay 10000 and ten posts in the Grade Pay of Rs.8900 has been created and appointed through the Government of India and not by the Central Board which undermines the power of the Central Board which was vested by virtue of the Employees' Provident Fund & Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952.

As such, it is requested that necessary modifications be made in the para 22A of the Scheme by inserting maximum scale of pay [Rs.67000 – 79,000 with annual increment @ 3% (pre-revised Rs.22400-525-24500)] which will be lower than one grade of CPFC (which is the Secretary rank and in the scale of Rs.80000/-), in place of Rs.14300 to Rs.18300.
