> Sub: Non-conducting of Departmental Promotion Committee meeting (DPC) inspite of providing relaxation in qualifying service and existing Recruitment Rules (RR) to continue without consultation of UPSC till amendment to the Act – reg.

Sir,

The EPF Officers' Association would like to bring to your kind notice the following on the subject cited.

Inspite of granting relaxation by your goodself in qualifying service for regular promotion from APFC to RPFC-II and RPFC-II to RPFC-I, the DPC is not being conducted for granting promotion thereby the relaxation granted has become immaterial. For the past two years no promotions have been granted which has resulted in stagnation of officers in the same cadre leading to low morale among the officers.

Further, the long pending matter of consultation with UPSC after amendment to the Act has been resolved by your goodself so that the officers of EPFO will get promotion and the Association would like to express our sincere gratitude to your goodself for resolving the issue. But the scenario remains the same as no DPC has been conducted so far. Various reasons have been stated but there is no major problem except the Administration domain problem.

As per the existing DOPT instructions, DPC should be conducted and a panel for the coming financial year should be readily available but the same has not been followed.

It is, therefore, requested that your goodself may kindly look into the matter and direct that a Departmental Promotion Committee meeting may be conducted immediately so that the greivance could be resolved and promotions granted to the deserving officers for which the officers fraternity will be grateful to you.
