- 2. Although it is a matter of concern that it took over three months to merely issue the minutes of the meeting held on 09.02.2023. However, a bigger issue for concern is that most of the issues discussed in said meeting remain unresolved even now.
- 3. In the minutes provided by the Head Office on 11.05.2023 against all agenda items, it is mentioned that "issue is under consideration" and "being examined". We hope that three months are more than sufficient for examining and considering

any issue and therefore we must humbly request that the final outcome may be intimated at the earliest. We also submit that for more than a year now EPFOA has been constantly pursuing with letters and representations for resolving the most important issues of promotion in the cadre of ACC and RPFC-I for filling all vacant posts, implementation of the Model Calendar for holding DPC, resolving the issue of NFSG to left out and eligible RPFC-I and circulation of final seniority list for all posts in Commissioner's Cadre. Unfortunately, even the routine issues like grant of STS and

meeting to discuss the issues related to Officers' Cadre. Thereafter, following issues were

discussed in the meeting as per the agenda items raised by the Association:-

Item No. 1: Inordinate delay in promotion to ACC(HQ) and ACC cadre :- Secretary General

stated that DPC for promotion to ACC(HQ) and ACC cadres be done timely and consequential

promotion orders may be issued. The issues related to promotion may be resolved at the

earliest.

It was informed that matter is under examination and would be placed before the

appropriate authority for decision.

[Action: HRM-I]

Item No. 2: Allowing Non-Functional Upgradation (NFU) to eligible officers, pending since

2012.

It was informed that the matter is under consideration.

[Action: HRM-I/ HRM-II]

Item No. 3: Allowing NFSG to left out eligible officers.

It was informed that the issue related to NFSG is under submission for fixing the date of

screening committee meeting.

[Action: HRM-I/ HRM-II]

Item No. 4: Allowing Senior Time Scale on completion of four years of service: - Secretary

General, EPFOA has requested for allowing STS to all eligible APFCs at the earliest.

It was informed that the screening committee has submitted its recommendations for grant

of STS to all eligible candidates and further action on the same shall be taken shortly.

<u>Item No. 5:</u> Up to date Updation and publishing of Seniority list for all grades in the Commissioners' Cadre particularly in the Grades of APFC and RPFC-II.

It was informed that Draft Seniority list for RPFC-I, RPFC-II and APFC cadres have been issued and uploaded on website for calling objections (if any).

[Action: HRM-I/II]

<u>Item No.6:</u> Issue of supernumerary post in APFC Cadre: - Secretary General, EPFOA raised the issue of Grant of 7450/- Grade Pay to EOs/AOs as on 01.01.2006 under the 6th Central Pay Commission.

It was informed that matter will be examined in due course.

[Action: HRM-II/ HRD]

<u>Item No. 7</u>: Recruitment Rules for Commissioners' Cadre: Secretary General said that earlier EPFOA was requested to forward a details proposal on the benefits of composite service rules for the Commissioner's Cadre along with relevant DoPT instruction for the same as well as the applicability of the same to EPFO. The same has been sent to HRD Division, Head Office in December, 2022 for consideration.

It was informed that the matter is under consideration.

<u>Item No. 8:</u> Prolonged pendency of disciplinary proceedings and consequential block in promotion opportunities to officers next in line & Faulty system of allowing VCC and resultant delays. :- Secretary General stated that process of vigilance clearance needs to be revamped and it should be time bound and system generated.

It was informed that matter will be examined shortly.

[Action: HRM/ Vigilance/ AVS]

<u>Item No. 9:</u> Refundable advance equal to two months' pay and DA on transfer.

It was informed that matter will be re-examined as per extant rules and provisions.

[Action: HRM- VII]

<u>Item No. 10:</u> Residential accommodation for EPFO officers:- Secretary General stated that lease amount is not sufficient as on date and requested to re-visit the issue at the earliest.

It was decided that a Committee of two (2) RPFCs II shall be constituted to examine the issue related to lease accommodation out of which one (1) member officer shall be suggested by EPFOA. The representatives of EPFOA agreed to the same. It was also decided that

committee shall submit its report in a time bound manner so as to take further necessary action in the matter (if required).

Item No. 11: Office vehicles for RPFC-Is posted in Zonal Offices and Training establishment.

It was informed that the Committee of 3 officers was constituted to review the policy for hiring of vehicles. The Report of the committee has been received and the same will be examined shortly.

<u>Item No. 12:</u> Enhancing strength of Group A commissioners' cadre.

It is informed that IIT Delhi has been appointed as a consultant for work study. This will help organisation with increasing workload and future challenges. Two representatives from association will be invited for suggestions.

<u>Item No. 13:</u> To facilitate access to work on real time basis- laptops may be allowed to all officers: Secretary General has informed that a committee was constituted during welfare meeting for exploring avenues to provide laptops and Mobile Phones to all AO/ EOs and above cadres whereas this issue needs to be examined in technical way instead of welfare. Secreatry General further suggested that computerisation budget may be used for the said issue.

It was informed that matter will be examined shortly.
