Reference is invited to the Final List of Contesting Candidates and Declaration of Members Elected Unopposed, No. EPFOA/Election/2026-28/04 dated 25.08.2026, and to the Voting Instructions and Rules for Counting, No. EPFOA/Election/2026-28/05 dated 25.08.2026. The poll in respect of the 1998 Batch of Direct Recruits and the 2024 Batch of Direct Recruits remained open from 0001 hours on 26.08.2026 to 2359 hours on 27.08.2026. The votes received have been read and counted by the undersigned in terms of para 6 of the said Voting Instructions. In terms of para 7 of Election Notification No. EPFOA/Election/2026-28/01 dated 12.08.2026, the result of the poll is published herewith.

Shri Sachiv Nehra, Assistant P.F. Commissioner, Regional Office Vadodara, having secured the highest number of valid votes, is declared elected as the representative of the 2024 Batch of Direct Recruits.

In both batches the candidates are shown in the order in which their nominations were received, as in the List of Nominations Received and in the Final List of Contesting Candidates.

4. Votes rejected. Every vote received was read by the undersigned alone in terms of para 6(x) of the Voting Instructions, and the reasons for every rejection have been recorded in writing in terms of para 6(ix). Of the four votes rejected, three were rejected under para 6(iii), two communications having been received from the same member naming different contesting candidates, a vote once cast being incapable of correction, alteration or substitution; and one was rejected as the sender could not be identified, neither the particulars required by para 4 nor the declaration required by para 5 having been furnished.

5. Elected Members of the Central Executive. The two members declared elected above, together with the seven members declared elected unopposed vide Order No. EPFOA/Election/2026-28/04 dated 25.08.2026, are the elected Members of the Central Executive for the term 2026-28. They are notified, and the directions consequent upon their election are issued, by Order No. EPFOA/Election/2026-28/07 of even date.
